We are pleased to announce a call for papers to be presented at the 2017 MTE-Partnership Conference and optionally included in the Conference Proceedings. Proceedings will also include reports from the plenary sessions and RAC work groups, along with editorial comment. (The 2016 Proceedings are now available online at www.aplu.org/MTE-P-2016-conference-proceedings.)

We invite papers for two types of presentation at the conference. The first type is a report of research that supports the aim of the Partnership, which may include work done as a part of a RAC. The second is a narrative of some aspect of your local site's efforts to improve your preparation of secondary mathematics teachers.

Title and abstract (240 words or less) are due March 15, 2017 using the following link: <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2017MTEPproposal>

You will receive confirmation whether your proposal has been accepted by March 30. If your proposal is accepted and you wish to submit a paper for inclusion in the proceedings, your paper will be due June 15, double-spaced, no longer than 12 pages (including figures and references).

Note that authors need to present at the conference in order to have their paper included in the Proceedings. If you submit a proposal for a paper to be included in the Proceedings, you will be asked to provide feedback for two other submissions in late June.
