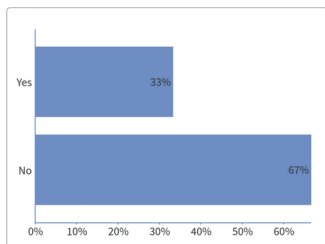

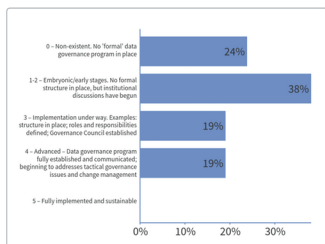

5 - Fully implemented and sustainable	0	0%

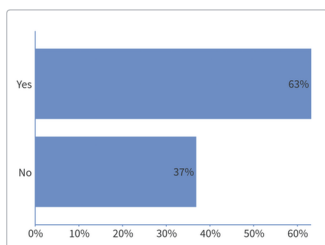

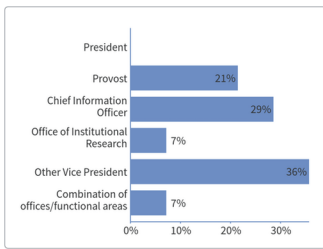

If "yes" in Q3, who serves as executive sponsor of the data governance program?

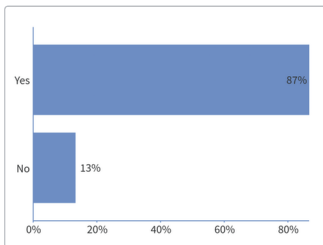

Functions (a). What university functions are represented in your institution's data governance program? Information Technology/Services

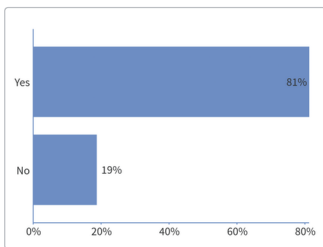

Functions (b). What university functions are represented in your institution's data governance program? Institutional Research

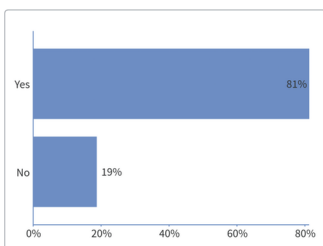

Functions (c). What university functions are represented in your institution's data governance program? Finance

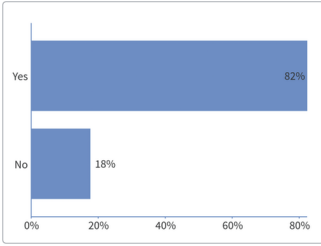

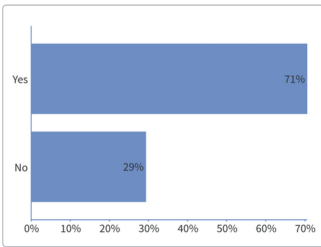

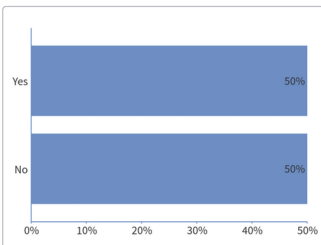

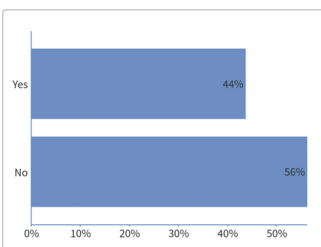

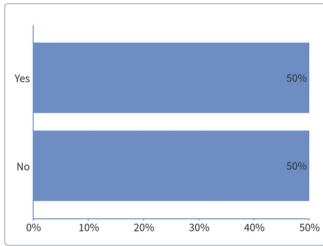

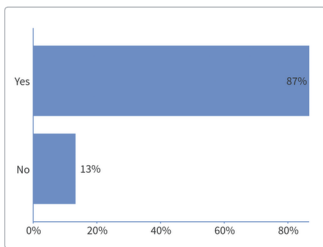

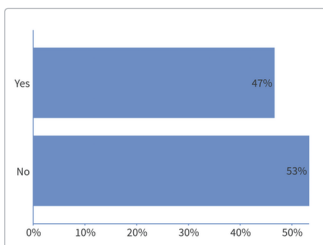

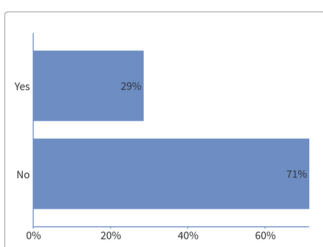

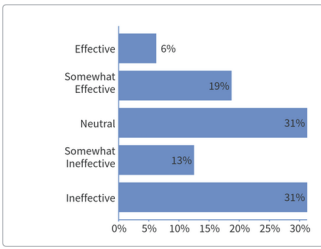
