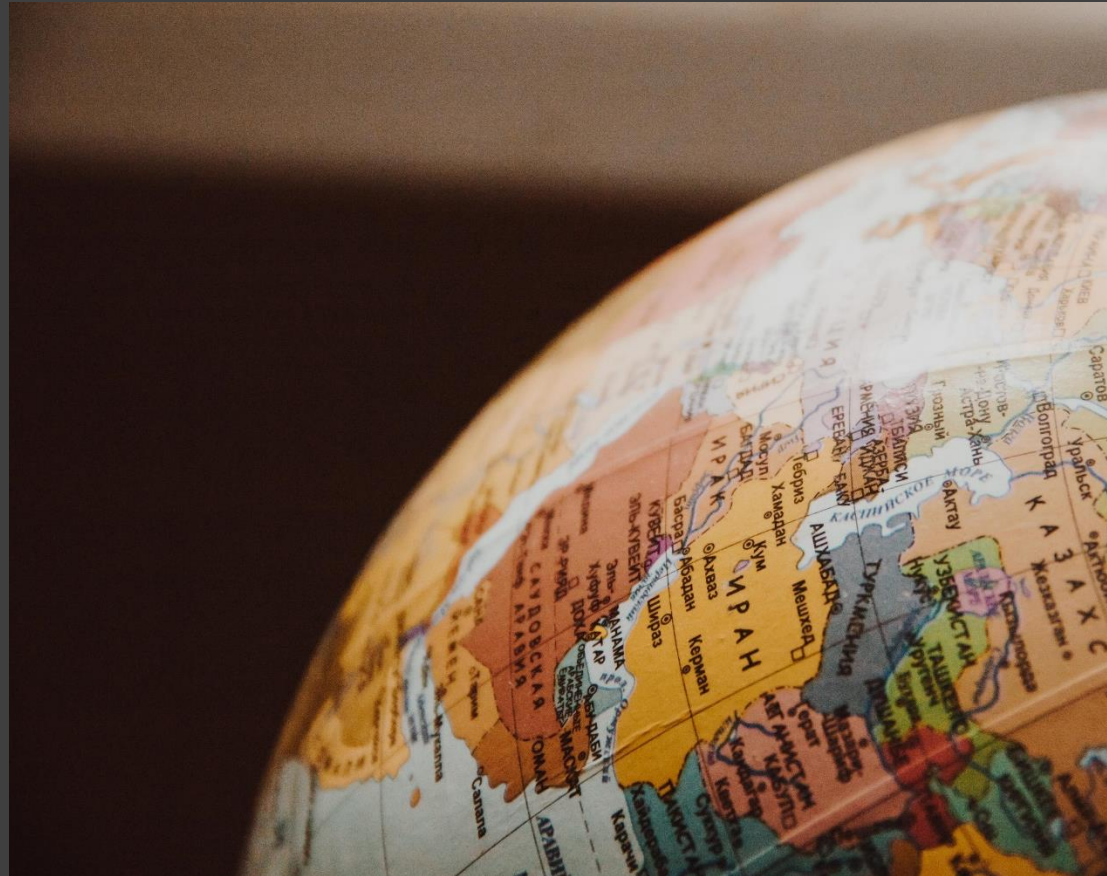
WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?

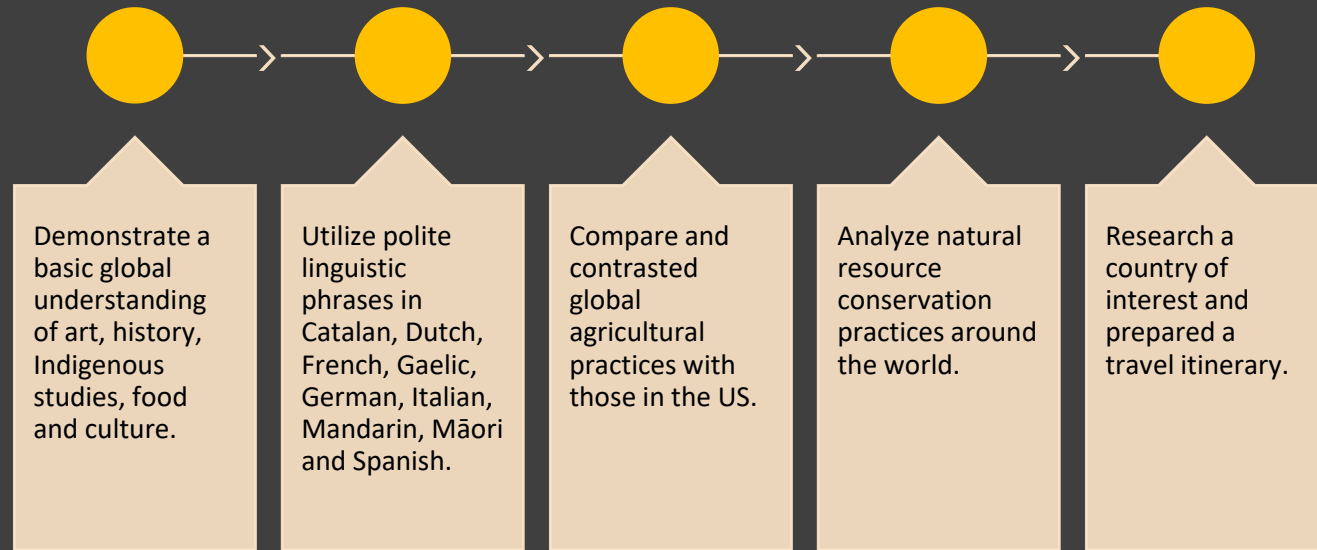

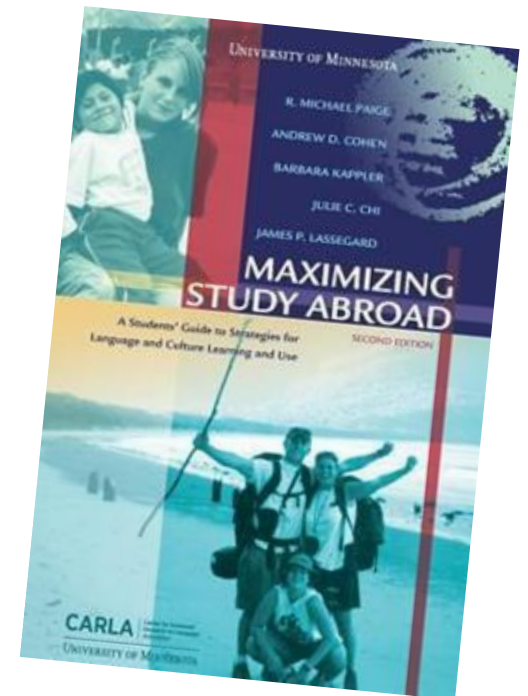
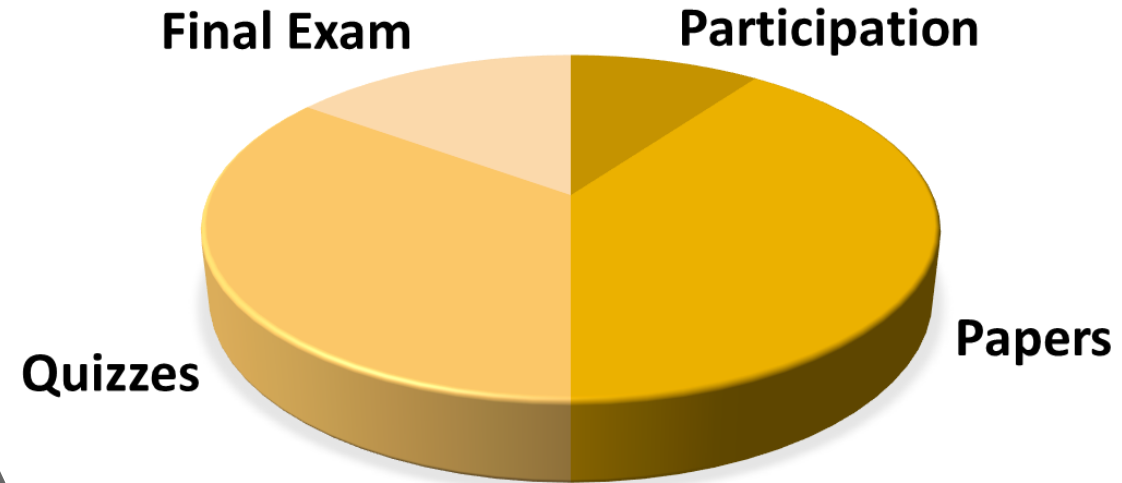

 - Research paper of a country not studied in class, including travel itinerary and class presentation.

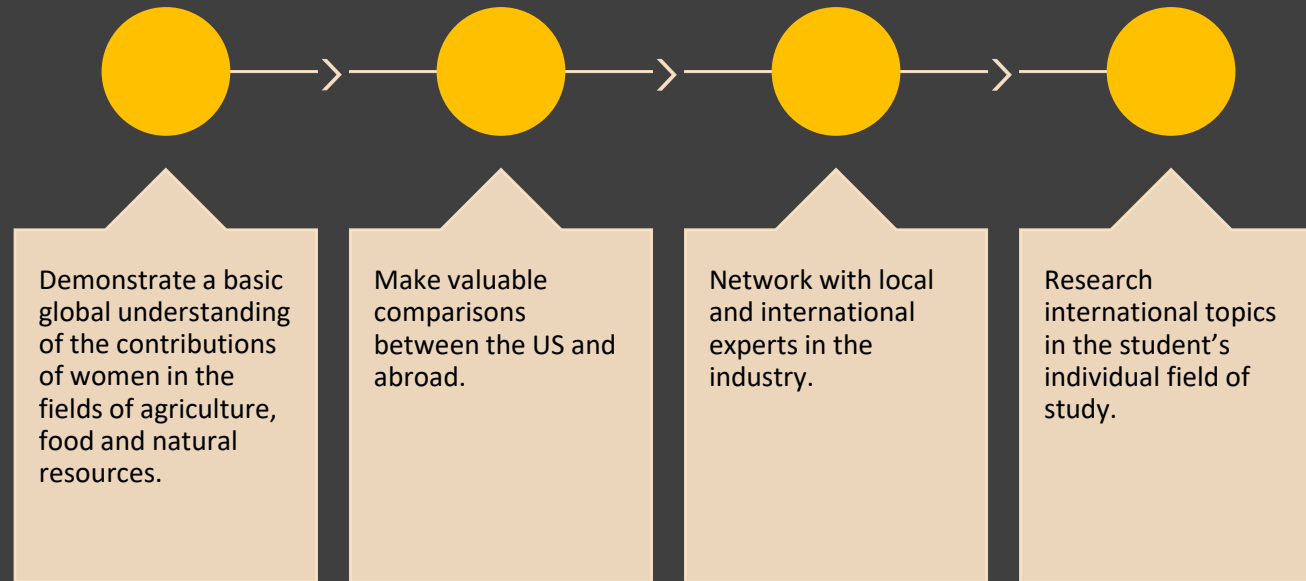

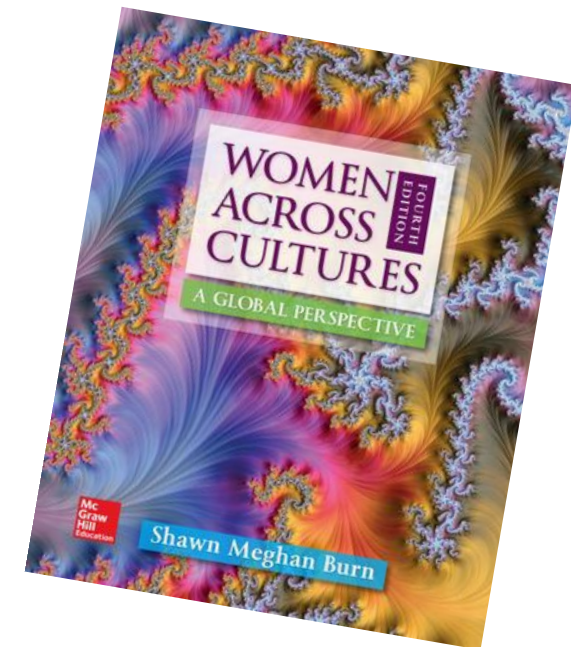
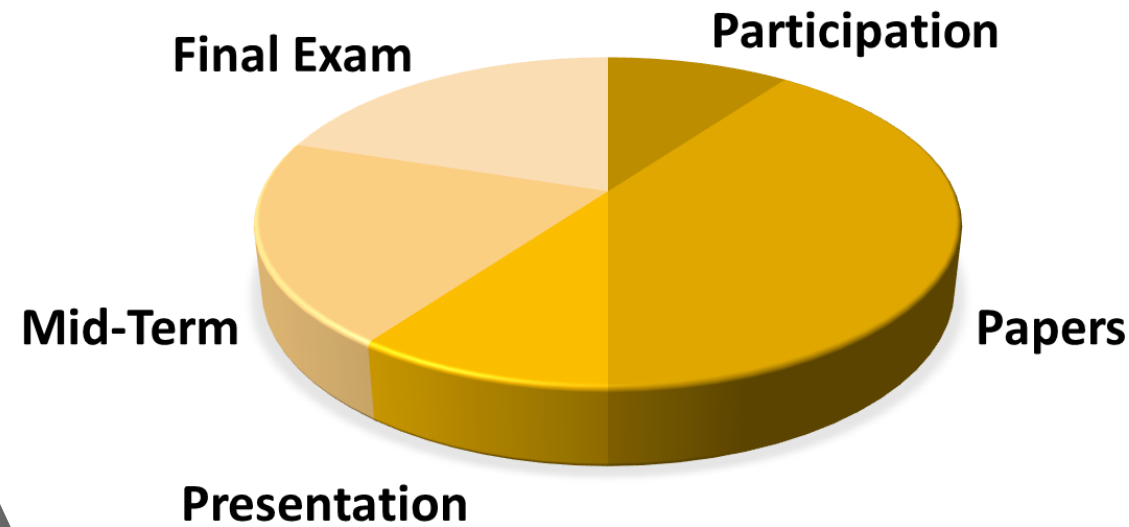
