Research a country of interest and prepared a travel itinerary.







- Class participation; attending all class meetings, engaging in course discussions/break-out sessions, and preparing questions to ask guest speakers.

Make valuable comparisons between the US and abroad.


Network with local and international experts in the industry. Research international topics in the student's individual field of study.


